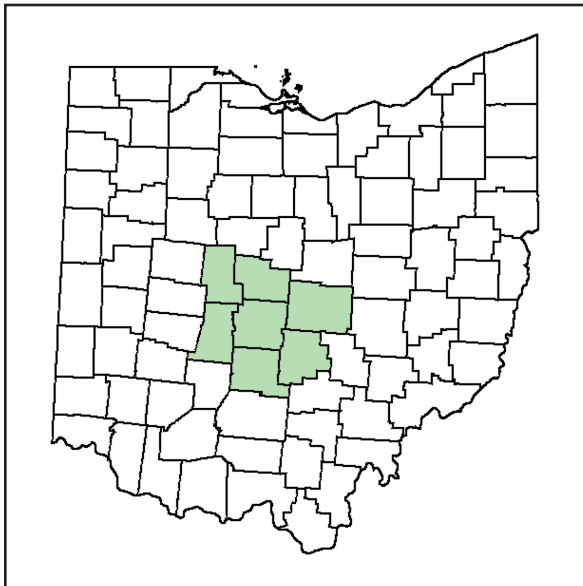

Location

Central Ohio; Encompasses Delaware, Fairfield, Franklin, Licking, Madison, Pickaway, and Union Counties. It contains 21 cities, 59 villages and 116 townships.



Services

Transportation Services

- Serves as the MPO for the region,
- Administers Infrastructure Funding and Planning for the Central Ohio region,
- Provides Data and GIS services to members and the public, and
- Administers the region's RideSolutions program.

Planning Services

- Administers the Clean Ohio Fund,
- Facilitates the Central Ohio Regional Growth Strategy which strives to create a common understanding of the dramatic change anticipated for the region over the next 20 to 30 years,
- The Air Quality Program seeks to inform, educate and alert individuals, businesses and organizations of the actions they can take to reduce ground-level ozone,
- Provides Aerial Photography, Census Data, Traffic Volumes, Land use and Demographic Forecasts to members and the public, and
- Administers the Greenways Program, which provides resources and guidance in the acquisition and management of open space.

Legislative Services

- Collaborates with and lobbies state and federal lawmakers on behalf of members, and
- Conducts policy analysis for members and the region's public.

Housing Services

- Provides a free, one time weatherization service for low-income families and seniors in Franklin County who are income eligible,
- Assists low and moderate-income families with homes repairs, and
- Offers a HUD-certified homeownership counseling program including: One-On-One Financial Counseling and Homeownership Training/Life Skills.
